2024 SUMMER ANIMAL LEAGUE GUIDELINES

1. **NEW this year!! Online Team Registration and Scoring!! It's easy, I promise! (Thank you, Matt!)**

2. **2024 League Dates:**
 - **Starting April 23rd, Kick-off meeting will be held at 5:30 at the practice range.**
 - **We will shoot the back half of the 3D course the first week.**
 - **Regular shooting for 11 weeks**
 - **No shooting the week of July 4th**
 - **Shoot offs and potluck dinner - July 16th**
3. League fee will be **\$50 for adults and \$25 for children 15 and under (family max \$150)**, please pay by June 1st.
4. **Spring Work Parties are scheduled for Tuesday April 16th and Saturday April 20th.**
 - Bring a pruner and/or chainsaw to help out with shooting lane clearing.
 - We will also need help painting targets. Matt Simcik has made beautiful templates so the painting should go quickly but we will need help spray painting them and cutting them out of cardboard.
 - There will be a list of other activities to help out with as well.
5. **The 2024 Summer Animal League will be a 4 person team league:**
 - 4 people per team, all participants must be members
 - If you don't have a team or if you are short a teammate, we will work with you to get that figured out.
 - If a team ends up w/less than 4 members a ghost score will be used for the open spot.
 - If children under age 16 are shooting on a team a paid adult league member **MUST** accompany them at all times on the range.
 - This league is meant to be fun, friendly competition. Scoring is on the honor system. Be safe and have fun! 🎯
6. **Scoring:**
 - Shoot 2 arrows at each target, 15 targets per week (30 shots)
 - Center of Lung/Vitals 10 ring - 10 points;
 - Lungs/vital - 8 points;
 - Body/cardboard - 5 points;
 - Miss the animal – 0 points
 - Arrow touching a scoring line, scores the higher points.
 - Absent Scoring: If you are unable to shoot a score your 3 week average less 15 points absent penalty (5 points per 5 target game)
 - Standings Win/Loss/Tie record –
 - Match points are based on a total of 4 points each week
 - 4 points for high total team score
 - 2 points for ties

- Scores for the current week must be shot between Tuesday starting at noon and the following Sunday by noon.

7. Handicap System

- This league will use shooting stakes as a handicap. The stake you shoot from (green, yellow, orange, blue) will be posted on the website each week.
- Youth and Traditional shooters will always shoot the green stakes.
- You will shoot from your assigned stake color. (You can shoot a longer stake for fun if you would like)
- The first 2 weeks everyone will shoot from one of 2 stake locations. Youth and Traditional archers will shoot from green stakes and everyone else will shoot from the orange Stakes.
- Stake color will be assigned based on your last 3 score average
 - **Green lowest scores: 10% of all shooters**
 - **Yellow lower scores: 20% of all shooters**
 - **Orange medium scores: 50% of all shooters**
 - **Blue, high scores: 20% of all shooters**

8. Work opportunities to help the summer league:

- **Set-up the course a minimum of 1 time during the season.**
 - There will be a sign-up sheet for each team to volunteer for set-up
 - Remember to mark down your set-up time as work hours
- **Maintaining targets and shooting lanes** on the front and back Animal League courses
 - Trimming shooting lanes and maintaining the target butts is a great way to get outside and get volunteer hours in.
 - All members, especially summer league participants, are welcome to help out with tree trimming and target maintenance.
 - Work hours spent on range maintenance count for your club work hour requirement, remember to mark down your hours in the log book in the clubhouse.

9. SHOOTING STAKE DISTANCES AND TARGETS

- **Shooting Stake Distance Guidelines**
 - Green - no more than 20 yards
 - Yellow - no more than 30 yards
 - Orange - no more than 45 yards
 - **Blue - No Limit! Be safe, but let's have fun with long shots this year!** 🎯
 - Stakes should be put in as much of a straight line as possible
- **Target Setup Guidelines**
 - **Course set-up should be completed on Sunday or Monday.**
 - Any target with a vital that is so shot up it's hard to see the score, should be replaced.
 - Make sure that there is an "open" shot to the vitals from each shooting stake for left-hand or right-hand shooters, and taller and shorter shooters.
